The Vienna Residence Orchestra is one of the best chamber orchestras in the world: each individual musician is a recognised solist in his or her own right, the orchestra has been welcomed as a guest in the great concert halls of the world: Mexico City, Montevideo, Paris, Berlin, Rome, Athens, Budapest are only some of the places which the orchestra has visited with its guest conductor Rudolf Nurejev.

Under the musical direction of professor Christian Pollack and the guest conductors Gerhard Lagrange, Hoyem-Cavazzo, Zoltán Daniel Janikovic, the Vienna Residence Orchestra gives concerts daily in Vienna's most beautiful palaces: in large and small instrumentations, with famous opera singers, ballet dancers and musical delicacies that are geared to the relevant motto of the season. The VRO's Mozart and Strauss concerts are thus amongst the cultural highlights of any trip to Vienna.

Beyond the programme itself, there is an interesting parallel connecting the Vienna Residence Orchestra and Wolfgang A. Mozart: The orchestra's home is the very palace in which Mozart gave some of his most remarkable concerts. The magnificent baroque palace Palais Auersperg is one of the main focuses of European history regarding music, politics and society: Besides Mozart, Joseph Haydn and Christoph Willibald Gluck wrote their contributions to world music here, the royal family Auersperg and the Swedish royal dynasty Wasa engaged in politics in the Palais, and manifested their display of aristocratic splendour in opulent festivities.

Today the Palais and the Vienna Residence Orchestra are under the direction of cultural manager Sylvia Moser who enhances Vienna's cultural life with these two Vienna institutions and their synergies.
